- Panels will be out to the site in 6 weeks
- Goal is to set 15 panels a day
- First precast scheduled to arrive November 14 18, 2023
- Opening of School November 4, 2024

- Solar Project at Eisenhower and old Southeast
- Solarfox School Package
  - Solar display system
  - o Educational display suitable to children
- Illinois School District Portfolio
- Offsets 90% of energy use
- Incentives
  - o 30% federal investment tax credit
  - o Ameren Smart Inverter Rebate \$250/kw
- Next Steps
  - Would need a letter of intent from the district
  - Project development agreement provides target pricing and terms
  - o 100% of maintenance would be required from Calibrant energy

NANIA - Energy Brokers (Becky Thompson and Aaron Raftery)

- Solar Consultant
- Solar Options
  - o On-site ownership mode
  - o On-site power purchase agreement
  - o Off-site community solar

- Process
  - o Feasibility studies
  - Oversee competitive RFP process
  - Assess vendor proposals
  - Negotiate contract terms
  - Observe construction process
  - o Energy savings verification
- Fee structure
  - Gets fee from portion of kilowatt cost unless the district were to go through whole process and back out
- Fee is a one-time cost paid by the developer
- NANIA would do all leg work in the process
  - o They would then bring bids to the district, vet them as a team, and bring to BOE for recommendation of approval
  - Do not have to accept lowest bid
- Have worked with 4 or 5 school districts
  - o Currently working with 2 school districts under contract
  - School Districts are newer division for NANIA
