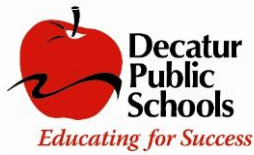

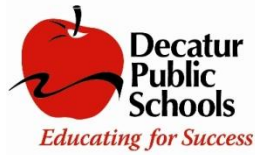

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The attached report illustrates the District's year-to-date revenues and expenditures and provides an explanation of the financial conditions of the Decatur Public School District and Macon-Piatt Special Education District.

CURRENT CONSIDERATIONS:

As the District completes July, the first month of FY26, the Macon-Piatt Special Education District has expended 3.00% of its overall budget; Decatur School District #61 has expended 5.07% of its overall budget.

As of September 02, 2025, the State Comptroller is holding FY26 ISBE vouchers in the amount of \$174,489 of which \$162,447 is associated with the Early Childhood Block Grant.

SEPARATION AGREEMENT

THIS SEPARATION AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 20th day of August, 2025, by and among the Board of Education of Decatur Public School District No. 61 (hereinafter “Board” or “District”), James “Jim” Dellert (“Dellert”), and Service Employees International Union, Local No. 73 (“Union”) (and collectively “the parties”);

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Dellert has, at all times relevant hereto, been a security guard and member of the Union employed by Board; and

WHEREAS, Dellert has determined it is in his best interest to resign and retire from the District effective September 1, 2025; and

WHEREAS, District desires that Dellert not return to his position, and desires that Dellert resign and retire effective September 1, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the parties have reached mutually acceptable terms and desire to memorialize the same in writing.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and mutual promises, covenants, and agreements contained herein, and for other valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. **Incorporation of Recitals.** The recitals set forth hereinabove are incorporated in this Section as if set forth herein word for word.
2. **Leave.** In consideration for his letter of resignation and retirement which shall be immediately irrevocable upon its delivery, and in further consideration for waivers set forth hereinbelow in paragraphs 3, 4, and 5, Dellert shall use his accumulated personal/universal leave

days through August 20, 2025, then shall be on paid administrative leave through August 29, 2025.

3. **Waivers.** Dellert hereby agrees and Dellert and does for his heir, heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, and each of them, release, remit, remise, acquit and forever discharge Board and its predecessors and successors, all individual members of Board (past, present and future), its employees, officers, agents, successors and assigns, from any and all matters of action, causes of action, grievances, rights or claims of rights, debts, dues, damages, liabilities, costs, claims, controversies, demands, torts, contracts, agreements, guarantees, indebtedness, obligations, expenses, accountings, warranties and choses in action, in law or in equity, including but not limited to grievances or unfair labor practices and of every nature and description whatsoever by reason of or in respect to any act, cause, matter, omission, right, duty, injury or thing that may have or has arisen out of the employment, work, or employment relationship of Dellert and District arising until the date of the execution of this agreement, whether known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected, latent or patent, or has at any time heretofore owned or held against the aforesaid parties or Board and including but not limited to:

- (a) Any claim, action, cause of action or liability arising under the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, the Illinois Human Rights Act, Titles VII and IX of the United State Code, or any or all other federal, state or municipal employment discrimination statutes, regulations or ordinances (including but not limited to those claims based upon age, gender, race, religion, national origin, handicap, disability or retaliation); and

- (b) Any claim, action, cause of action or liability arising under any other federal, state or local statute, law, ordinance or regulation.

This Agreement shall be enforceable against any party in the event of breach alleged by another.

4. **Union Waivers.** In consideration for its support of Dellert and this Agreement, Union hereby agrees to forever discharge Board and its predecessors and successors, all individual members of Board (past, present and future), its employees, officers, agents, successors and assigns, from any and all matters of action, causes of action, grievances, rights or claims of rights, debts, dues, damages, liabilities, costs, claims, controversies, demands, torts, contracts, agreements, guarantees, indebtedness, obligations, expenses, accountings, warranties and choses in action, in law or in equity, including but not limited to grievances or unfair labor practices and of every nature and description whatsoever by reason of or in respect to any act, cause, matter, omission, right, duty, injury or thing that may have or has arisen out of the employment, work, or employment relationship of Dellert and District arising until the date of the execution of this agreement, whether known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected, latent or patent, or has at any time heretofore owned or held against the aforesaid parties or Board.

5. **ADEA.** In separate consideration for Dellert's knowing and voluntary waiver of rights under the Age Discrimination in Employment Act (ADEA), the Board shall pay to Dellert the sum of one dollar (\$1.00), the value, receipt, and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged and accepted. Dellert acknowledges that he may have rights under the Older Workers Benefit Protection Act (29 U.S.C. 626, *et seq.*) and/or the Age Discrimination in Employment Act (29 U.S.C. 621, *et seq.*) and explicitly waives knowingly and voluntarily any rights he may have under said Acts. Dellert acknowledges that, since first reaching agreement with District, he had at least twenty-one (21) days to consider his options with respect to the

provisions of this agreement. Dellert shall have seven (7) days from his execution of this Agreement to change his mind and rescind agreement.

6. **No precedent.** This agreement shall not establish a precedent of any kind as to any issue addressed herein, and shall be disregarded as guidance for future situations of similar nature or kind.

7. **Making of this Agreement.** Each of the parties hereto has entered into this Agreement as their free and voluntary act. Each of the parties hereto has had the advice and benefit of counsel in making this Agreement, or the opportunity to seek the same, and know and fully understand the terms of this Agreement.

8. **Entirety of Agreement.** This agreement constitutes the whole and entire agreement between the parties. No prior agreement, negotiations, relationships, understanding, course of dealing, or usage forms any part of this agreement.


9. **Applicable Law.** This agreement has been executed in Illinois, and shall be governed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois in every respect.

10. **Paragraph Headings.** Paragraph headings have been inserted for convenience and reference only, and if there shall be any conflict between any such headings and the text of this agreement, the text shall control.

11. **Mutual Intent.** The language contained in this agreement expresses the mutual intent of the parties, each of which has had the opportunity for and benefit of counsel, advisement, and adequate consideration.

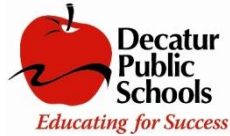

With rising energy costs and increasing building comfort control requirements, coupled with failing 14-year-old Roof Top Unit controls, ENTEC (Building controls and automation company) has quoted a controls upgrade for Stephen Decatur Middle School. The controls function intermittently, due to age, and in many cases have failed completely. In these cases, the controls have been bypassed to make them operational to maintain building comfort as best as possible. In addition to updating existing controls, CO2 controls, humidity controls, and variable speed fan controls will be added to 9 units that do not currently have these control options.

The existing factory controls are 14 years old and do not maintain consistent space temperature control in addition to experiencing increased failures. We propose furnishing the following scope of work:

(9) Constant Volume RTU's

1. Furnish and install DIBT Controllers on the existing RTU's.
2. Furnish and install Delta Electronics VFDs to allow single zone VAV control.
3. Furnish and install CO2 sensors in the return air duct.
4. Replace the existing temperature and humidity sensors with new sensors.
5. Reuse damper actuators, switches, relays, etc.

(6) Variable Air Volume RTU's

1. Furnish and install DIBT Controllers on the existing RTU's.

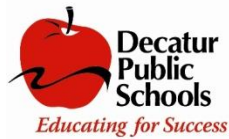

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Due to rising energy costs, maintenance staff and ENTEC (Building controls and automation company) propose to insulate and upgrade the piping system at SELA. The tunnel system below the school houses the pipes that distribute the hot water to the individual air handlers throughout the building. The current design does not allow for fine control of water temperatures based on exterior temperatures (lower outside temps require hotter water). This wastes energy and overheats the spaces above the tunnels. ENTEC will provide and install a three-way valve into the piping system and DPS staff will insulate pipe in the tunnels.

CURRENT CONSIDERATIONS:

- ENTEC submitted a quote to furnish and install a 3-way valve to allow hot water reset of the hot water loop serving the building at a cost of \$26,420.00
- DPS Maintenance staff will insulate pipes at a cost of \$12,240.88
- An application has been pre-approved by Ameren and an incentive in the amount of \$8,464.00 have been reserved for this project #2500910.
