 Implement intentional learning experiences that develop each student's core academics, personal strengths, and individual interests with the development of an Associate's Degree upon graduation.









### **Other Information**

- DPS electives are still **very** limited due to the tight schedule of meeting the requirements of both the degree and diploma. Each student should continue to work with their Counselor on their 4-Year Plan.
- Band and AG courses cannot be guaranteed in your student's schedule. Please have this discussion with your student and make the decision of what's best for your student upfront.
- Each student receives one MacBook!
- Transportation provided to RCC during junior and senior year.
- Prep Academy students will be taken on college visits.
- Students will have an adult Mentor for support + college mentors available to assist students.
- College Mentors at the buildings available to assist before and after school.
- Required GPA to remain in PA is 2.75 or higher at DPS and RCC. Students that do not maintain this GPA, will be transitioned out.
- <u>Discipline, grade checks, and progress monitoring is on-going, and students must strive to represent themselves and the program at high standards, or students can be transitioned out of Prep Academy.</u>

# Completed application includes:

- Attendance required at Student informational session
- Attendance required at Parent informational session
- One letter of recommendation required more are welcomed
- Five paragraph essay required on why they want to be accepted into Prep Academy program and how they plan to succeed
- Report card

Completed application, along w supporting documents must be electronically submitted via School Mint. Only fully completed applications will be reviewed.

February 21, 2025- Application Deadline in SchoolMint.

- Reviewing committee will review grades and student assessment data (FastBridge and IAR), discipline data, and attendance on each fully completed application submitted
- Building level recommendations will also be considered




OPTION 1: Click on (red) Book Session to select the Parent Webinar you plan to attend.

NOTE: Must go back to SchoolMint and finish the application after you leave the Zoom website.


